

*Stiftung Jugendhilfe aktiv* is one of the largest youth welfare agencies in Baden Württemberg. As a non-profit church foundation, our institution is characterized by a Christian attitude.

It is therefore important for us to approach our clients and students as well as our employees and cooperation partners with esteem and respect and to accept the plurality of opinions and attitudes. Important cornerstones of our work are responsibility, reliability, open communication and the promotion of personal growth.

Our Foundation was created in 2006 from two traditional children and youth welfare institutions, *Paulinenpflege* and *Wilhelmspflege* in Stuttgart. Previously, in 1990, the *Wilhelmspflege* had taken over the *Theodor-Rothschild-Haus*, formerly State Orphanage, in Esslingen.

900 employees, coordinated by the three main locations Plieningen, Rohr and Esslingen, support more than 1,700 children, adolescents and families in the Stuttgart region, Esslingen, Böblingen, Calw and Ludwigsburg districts.

*Dietrich-Bonhoeffer-Schule* and *Albert-Schweitzer-Schule* are affiliated to the Foundation. They offer special and inclusive education and counseling centers with a focus on emotional and social development at Stuttgart-Plieningen and -Rohr, Esslingen, and at more than 30 decentralized locations.

The *Psychologischer Fachdienst* (Clinical Team) is represented in all three regions of the Foundation and supports the educational work of the staff.

Our Education and Training Institute *fobi: aktiv gGmbH* offers space and time for new ideas and knowledge with seminars, lectures, symposia or workshops. Our school supervisor company *Schulbegleitung und Jugendhilfe aktiv gGmbH* supports more than 70 students individually during school lessons. Both of them are non-profit companies and wholly owned subsidiaries of *Stiftung Jugendhilfe aktiv*.

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
